I made it stand up!



We talked about how we used to not be able to write our names or read words but we kept on trying and didn't give up.



It keeps on breaking!




I can tell you about a time I didn't give up until I achieved my goal




I can run fast now

I can set a goal and work towards it




Jigsaw Jenie was able to build the tower because he kept on trying.
