"I chose squares and circles."

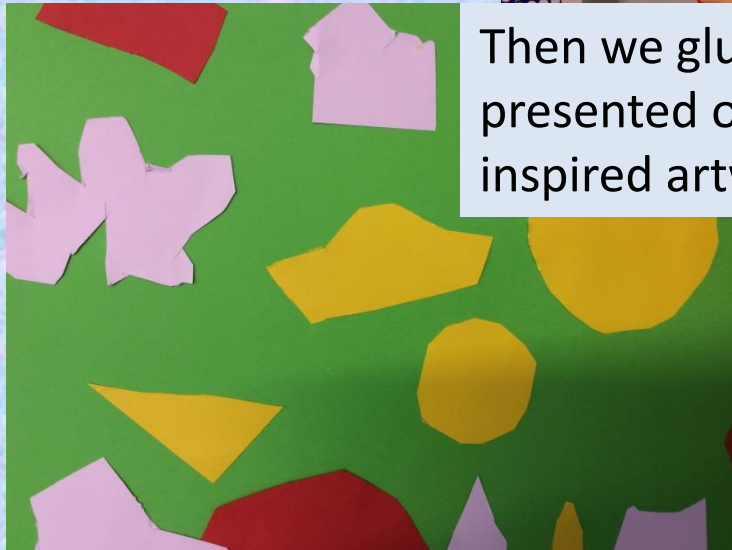
"I made a squiggly shape to look like an animal."



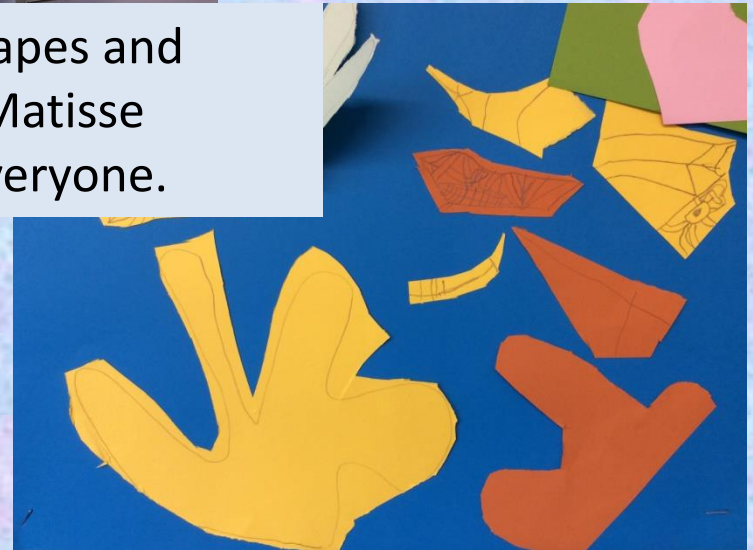
Next, we placed our shapes on our chosen background colour and moved them around until we were happy with their position.

Forever Facts

Henri Matisse was born in France.

Henri Matisse liked to use strong colours in his artwork.

Card and paper can be cut to create shapes that can be used to represent things.

Henri Matisse made cut paper collages when he was older and he called it 'painting with scissors'.

Autumn and Winter are two of the seasons.

Warm colours make us think of sunny, warm and cosy things.

In Autumn, the weather begins to get colder and deciduous trees lose their leaves. The leaves change from green to red, orange, yellow or brown before falling off the tree.

Cool colours make us think of fresh, calm and chilly things.

A tint is made by adding white to a colour to reduce darkness.

Winter is the coldest time of the year and some animals hibernate during this season.
