Subject Specific Vocabulary

Running Stitch	a straight stitch where the needle is passed in and out of the fabric with a regular pattern.
Overcast stitch	a stitch that closes the edge of the fabric.
Evaluate	looking carefully at a product and identifying what makes it good and how it can be improved.
Threading	is the process of putting the thread through a needle and knotting it.
Fillings	are different materials that can be used inside a sewn object.
