





Saint Piran and Saint Petroc




St Piran is a bit like the Prophet Muhammad, he is a messenger for a different God.

We had pasties on March 5th and scones.




Saints in Cornwall




We looked on a map of Cornwall to see how many places were named after Saints. There were so many more than we thought there would be.

I never knew there were so many places and I never knew St meant a real saint person.




How to behave in sacred places




You definitely shouldn't shout or leave your rubbish there.

We looked at photos of some special, local sacred places such as the Hurlers and we also found out about some items in a church. We remembered a few from previous learning.




In a sacred place you should be quiet so people can think.

I know that people should behave in a quiet and respectful manner when visiting a sacred place.



Skills
