TELL a trusted adult.




We discovered that “pop up” adverts will try and sell us things and that we should not click on them. We searched websites for these “pop ups” that Mr Gargan gave us.




If someone could see your private info, what would they do?

We also found out that you have to be ABSOLUTELY precise otherwise the computer will not be able to deliver the email.






Online Communities are people that have similar interests to us online.
