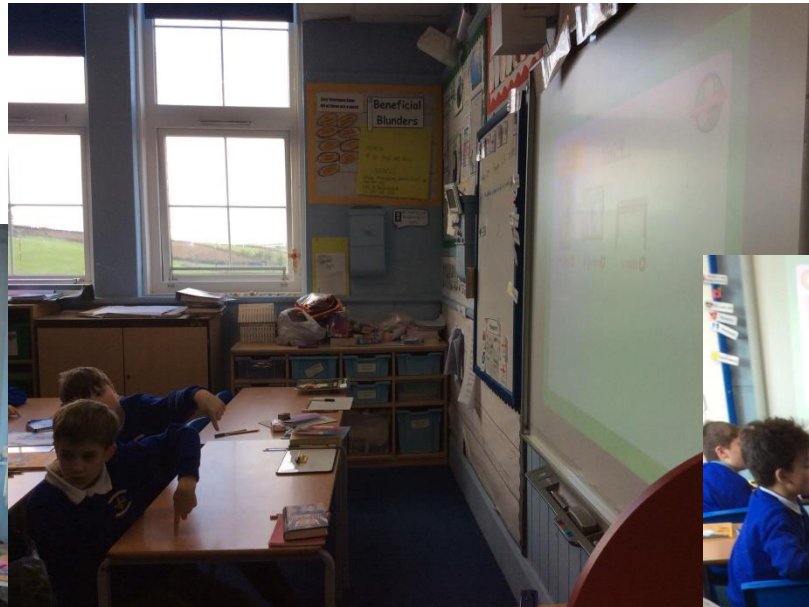
Class Lynher

First we learnt the French words for school subjects and spoke in a sentence to say which we liked.



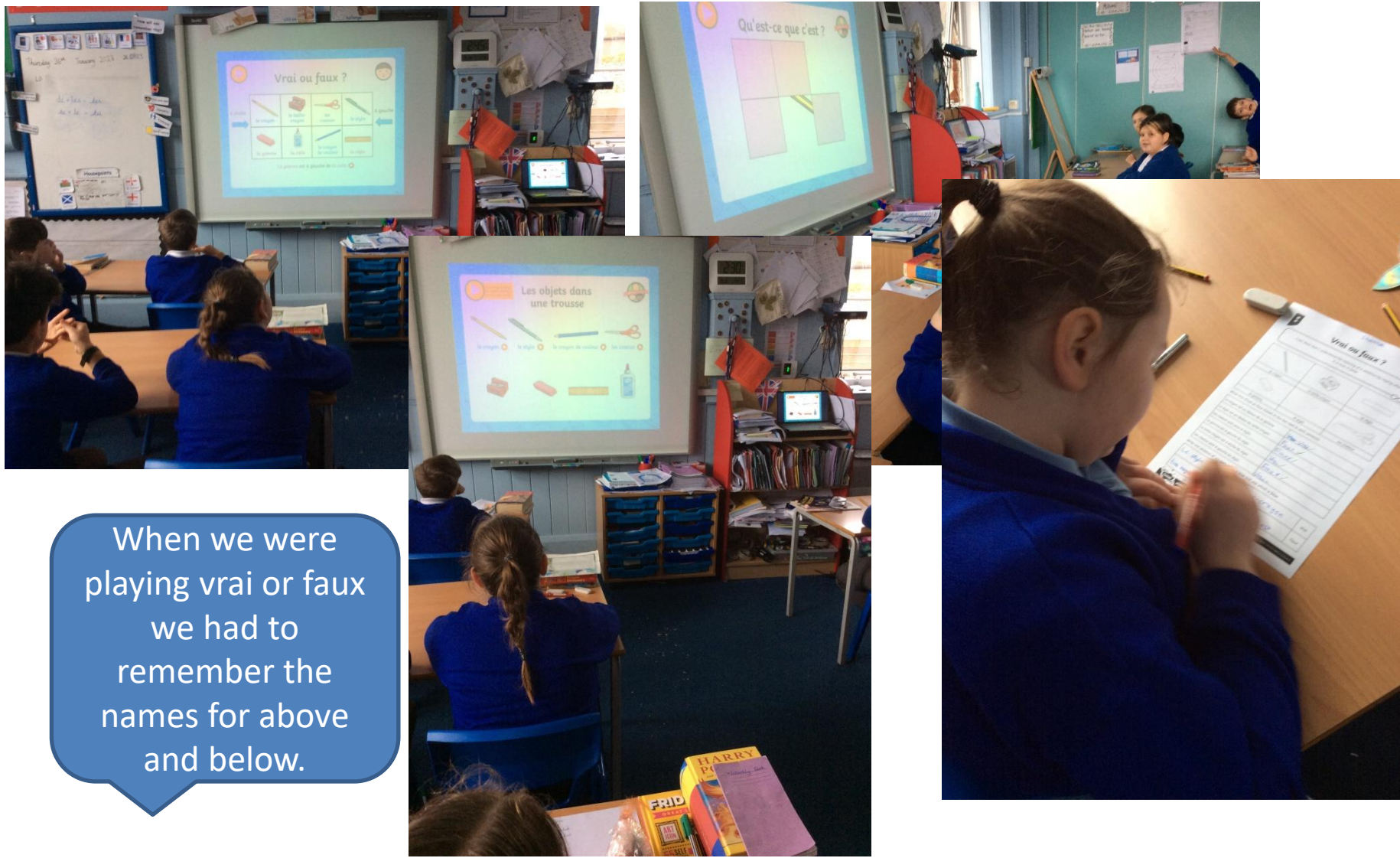
We played pairs to help us learn the names of the subjects.

We learnt how to say someone is next to something and used the pronouns for he and she.



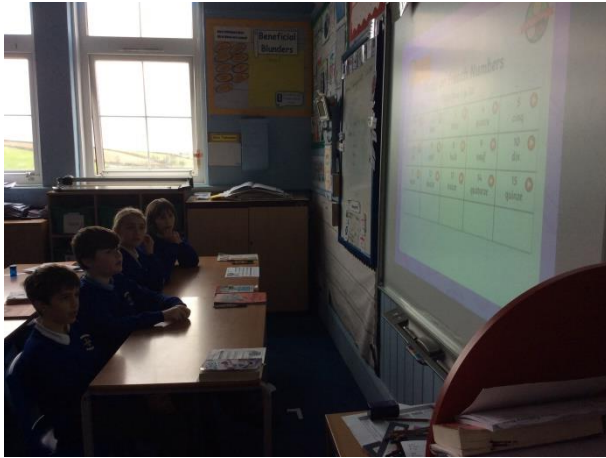
We had to remember the names of the furniture to know where they were.

We then learnt to use other prepositions to say where objects were.

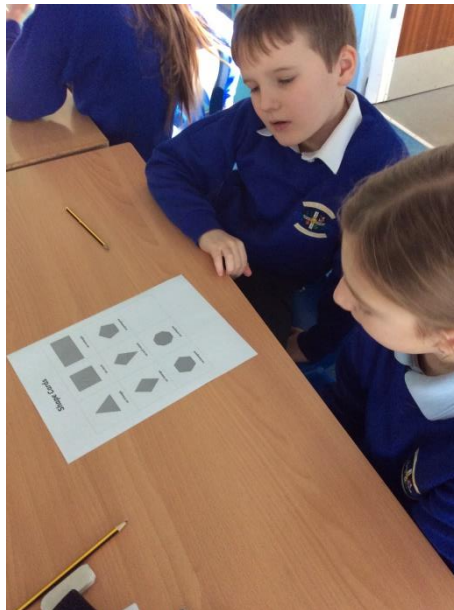


When we were playing vrai or faux we had to remember the names for above and below.

We used French to ask and answer maths questions for this lesson. We started with a loop game and then asked and answered questions about shapes.



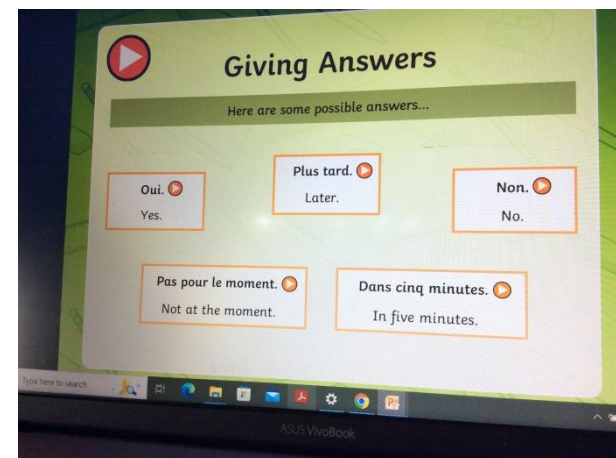
I liked the loop game

beginning.



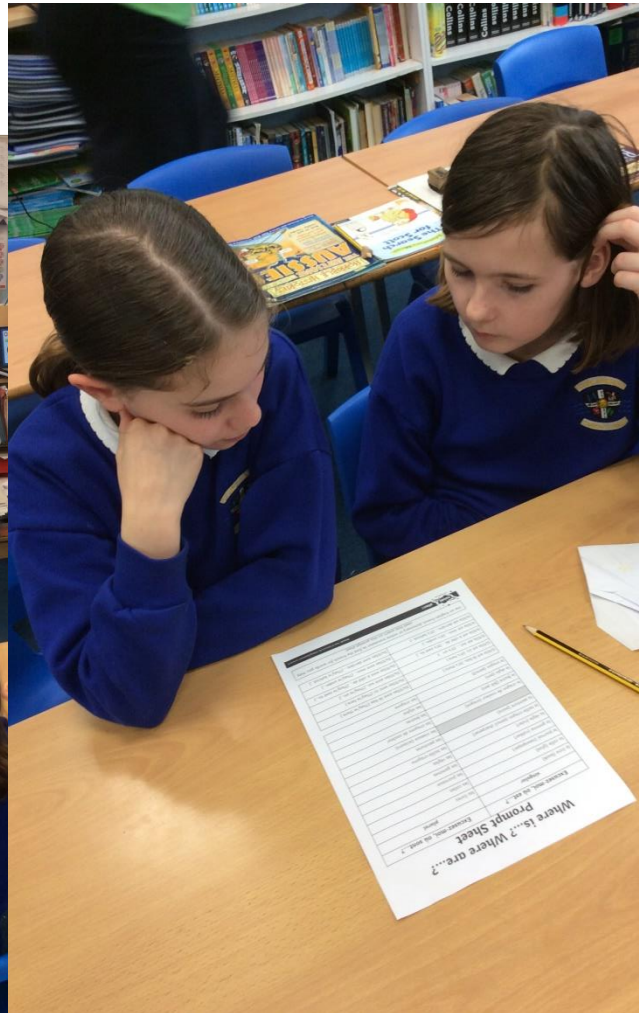
For this lesson we learnt how to politely ask and answer whether we could do something in school.



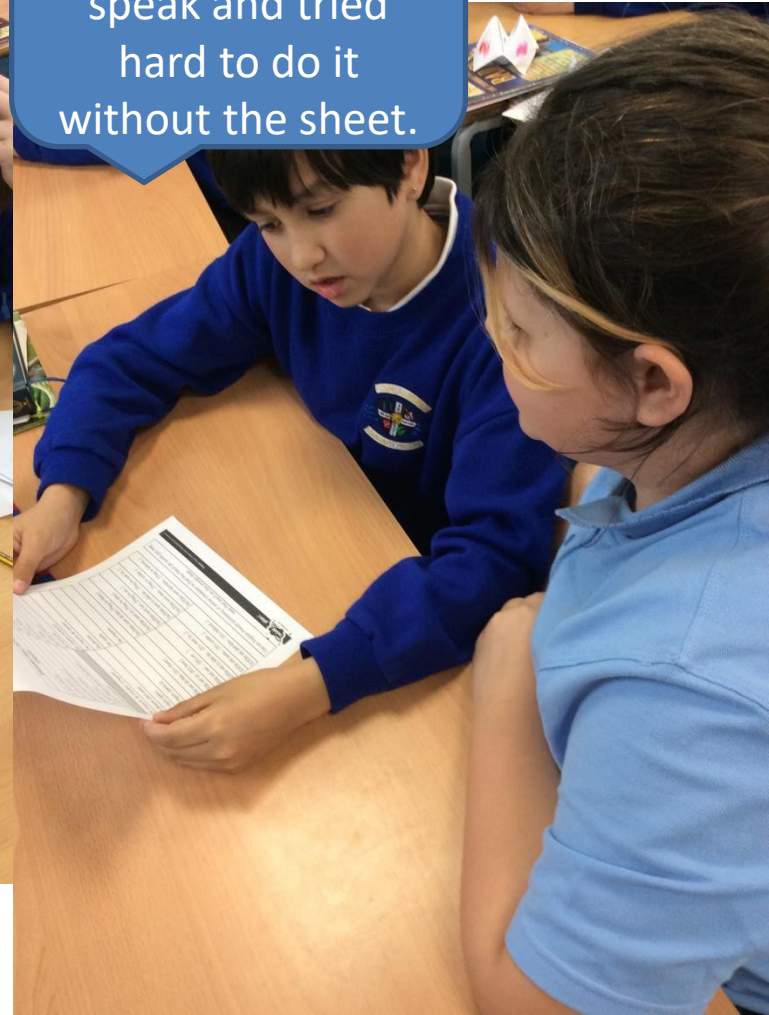
I liked learning how to be polite using excusez-moi which is excuse me.

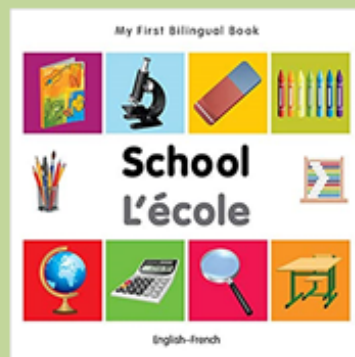
