

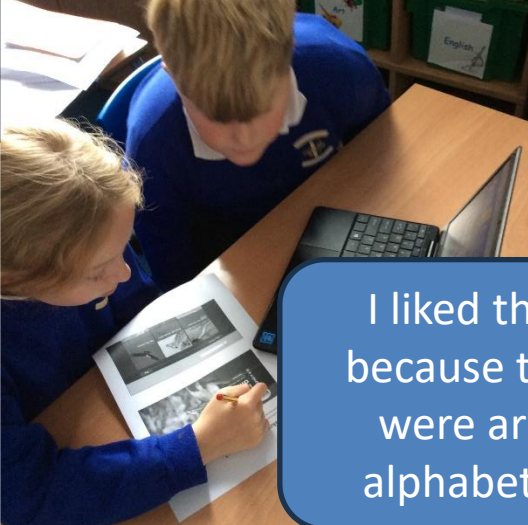

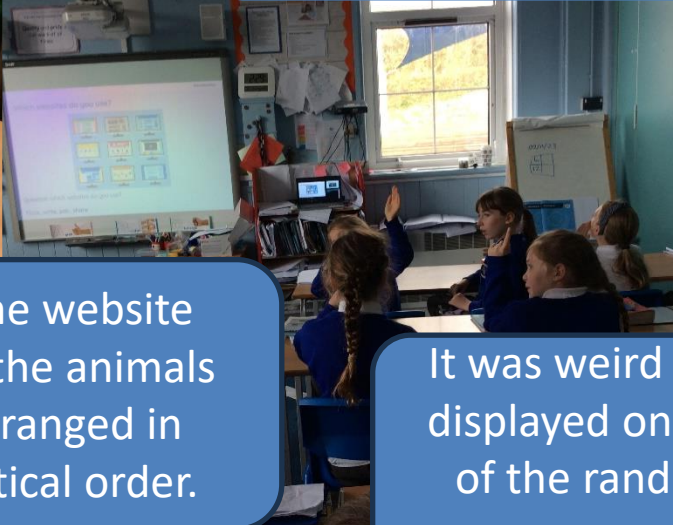

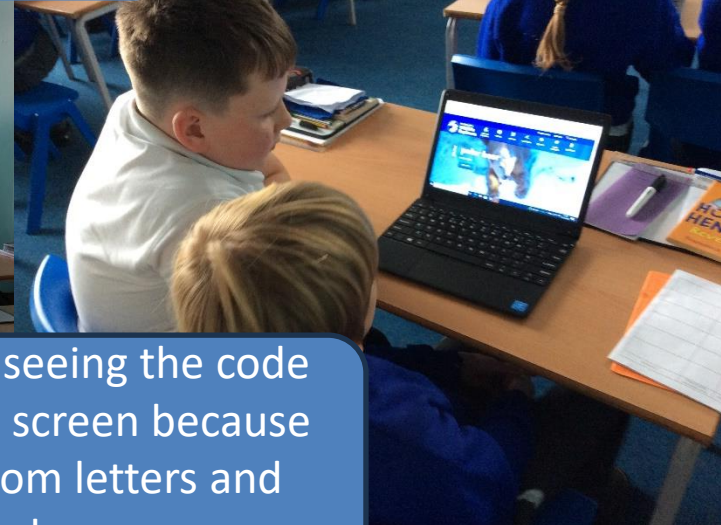
In this lesson we discussed what a website is and explored the San Diego Zoo website. We learnt that HTML code is used to write a web page.

It was weird seeing the code displayed on screen because of the random letters and numbers.



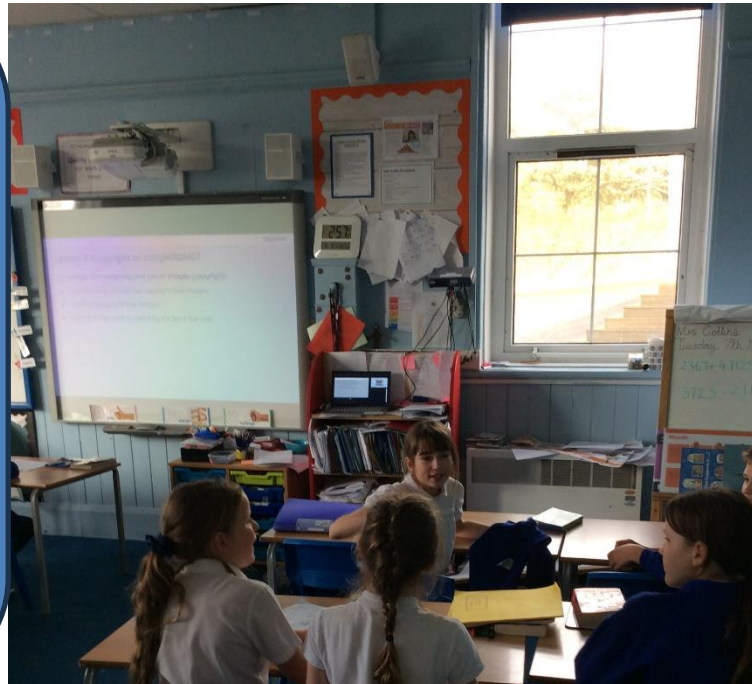
We discussed what you would expect to see on a home page of a website and looked at how you can use google slides to design one. We then got into groups and started to design our own on paper.



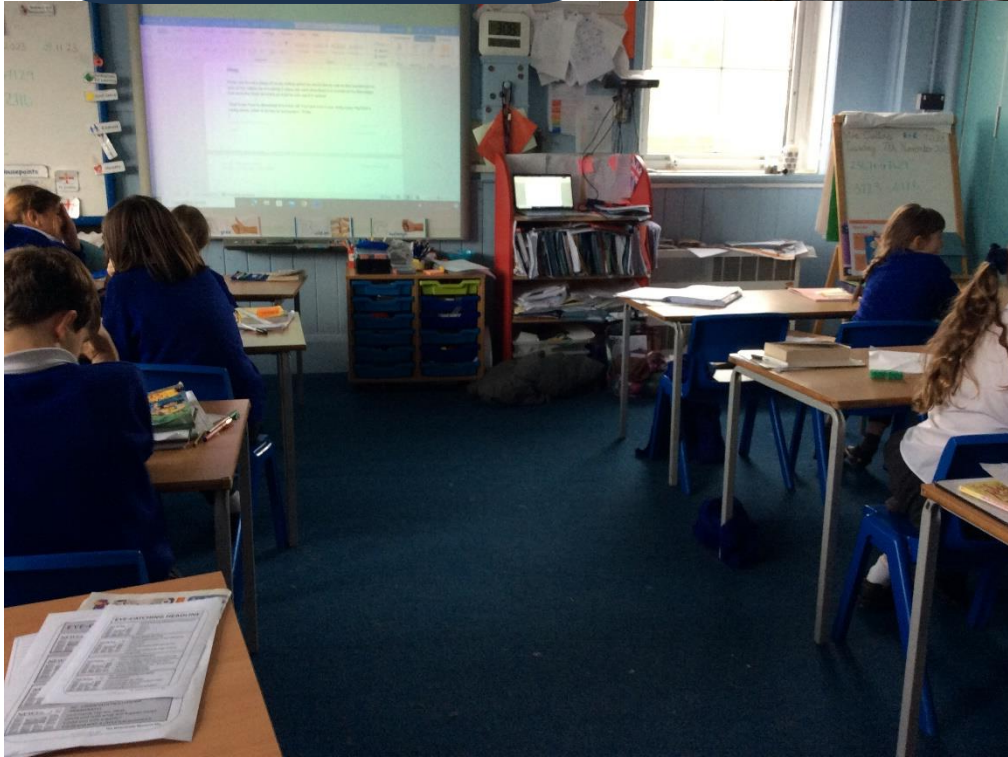
It was quite fun learning how to make a webpage and coming up with our own ideas.



We discussed copyright and looked at different scenarios to decide if the images used had been added appropriately. We then thought about what this means for our own web pages.

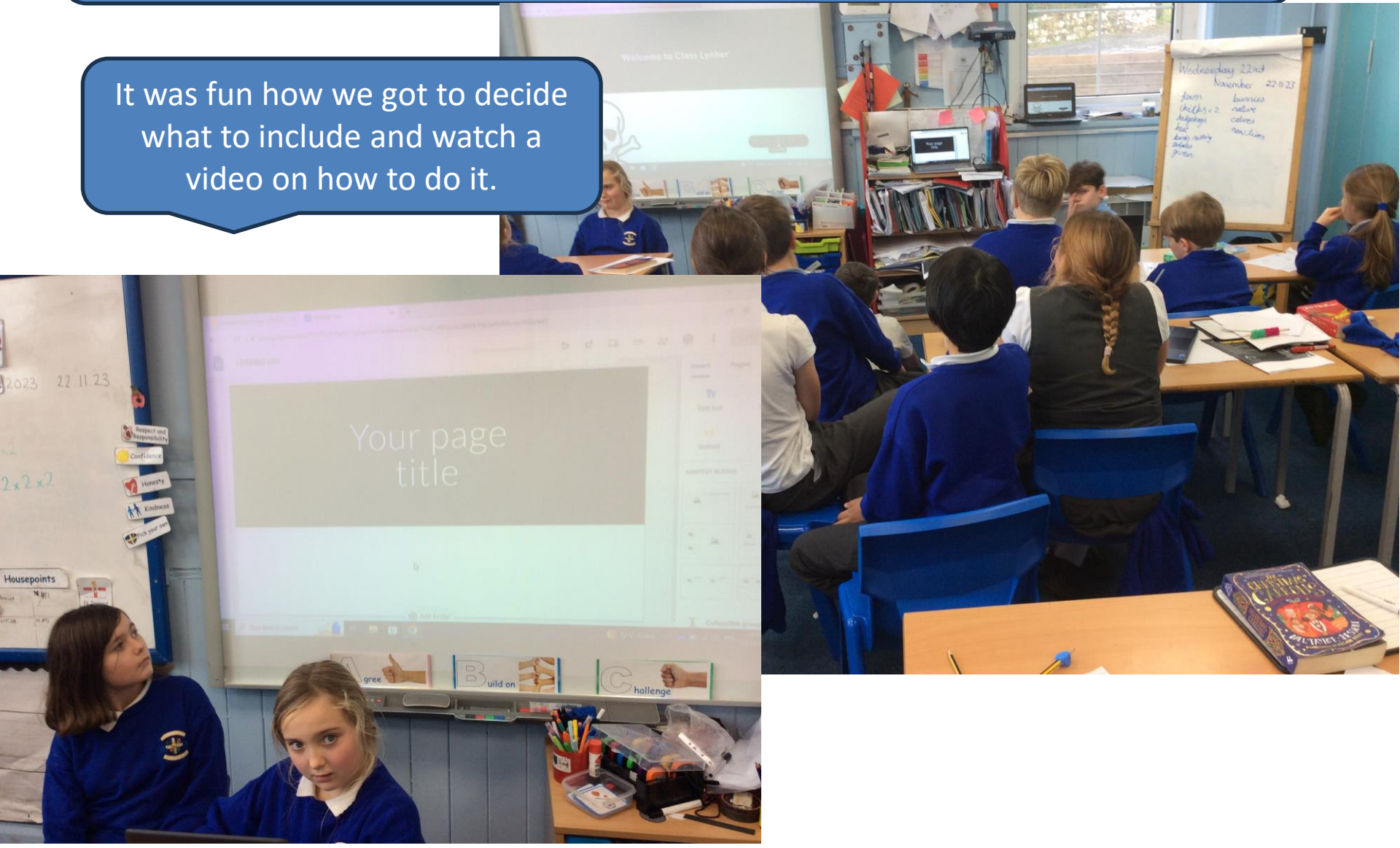


It means that if someone has put time and effort into making something and you just use it, it isn't fair on the other person.



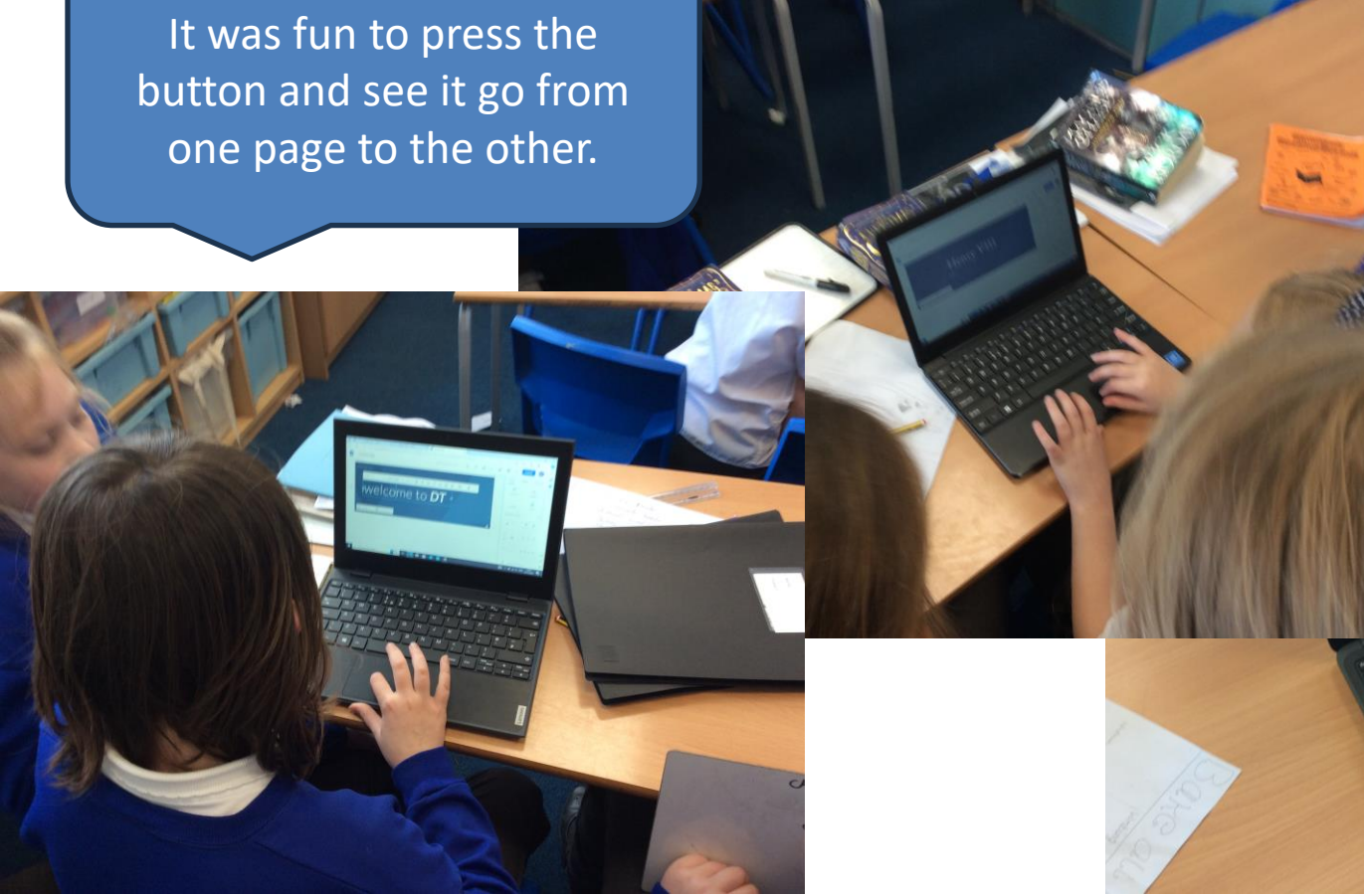
We started to create our web page using our plan. We used the preview to see what it would look like on different devices.

It was fun to press the button and see it go from one page to the other.

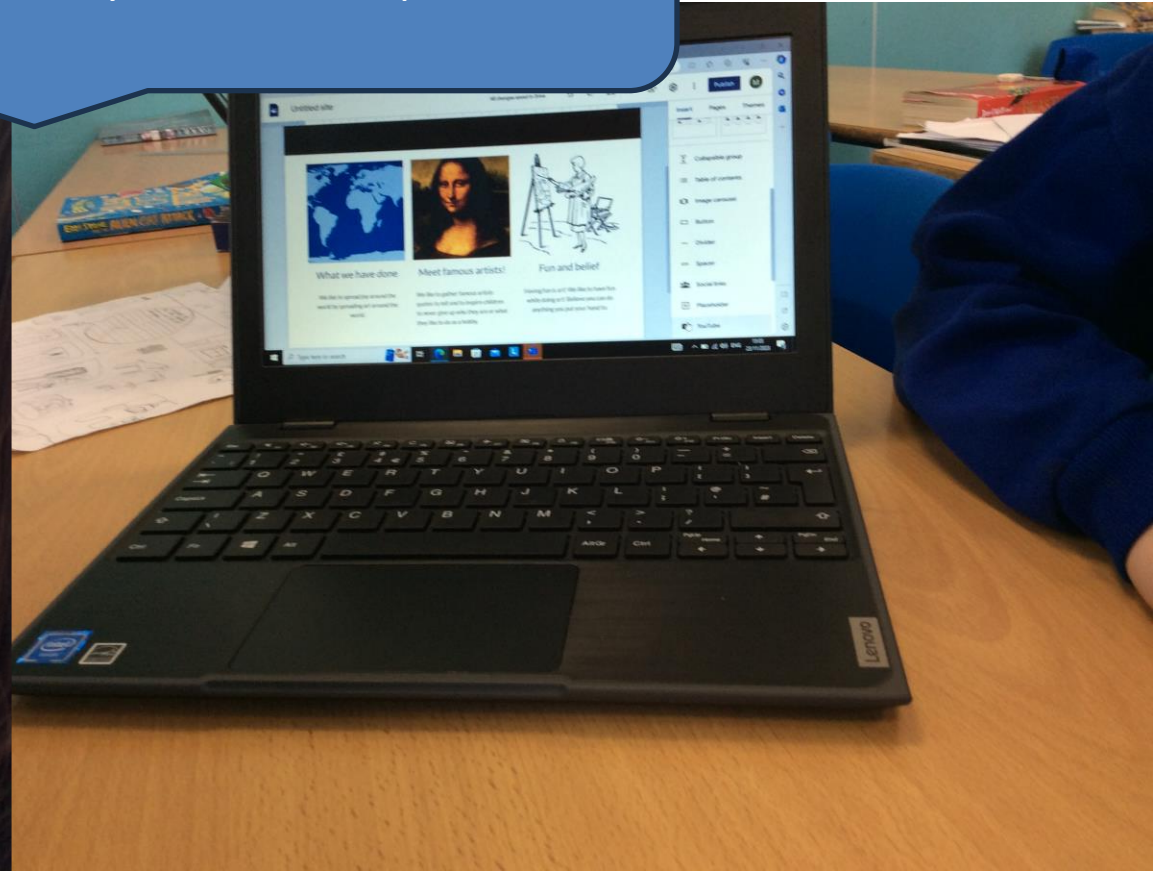




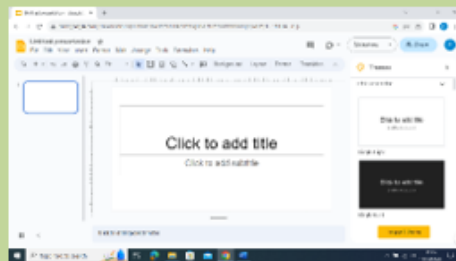
Finally we thought about how to be careful when linking to other people's work and created hyperlinks. We also learnt how to embed a video. Then we evaluated what we had done.

Subject Specific Vocabulary

HTML	Hyper Text Markup Language – a standardised language used to define the structure of web pages
fair use	Fair use permits a party to use a copyrighted work without permission for specific purposes
Copyright	The right to copy – usually held by the creator of the work
home page	The introductory page of a website
preview	an opportunity to view something before it is made generally available
navigation path	This directs a user along a predetermined route through a site
hyperlink	text or media that when clicked takes a user to another specified location
