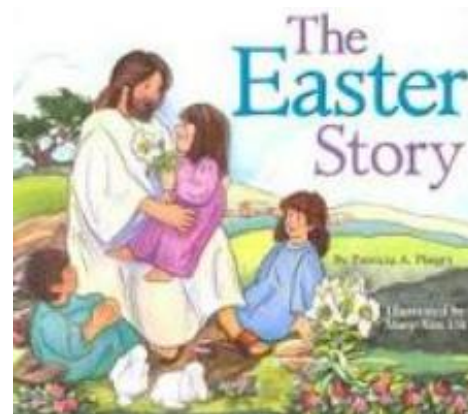
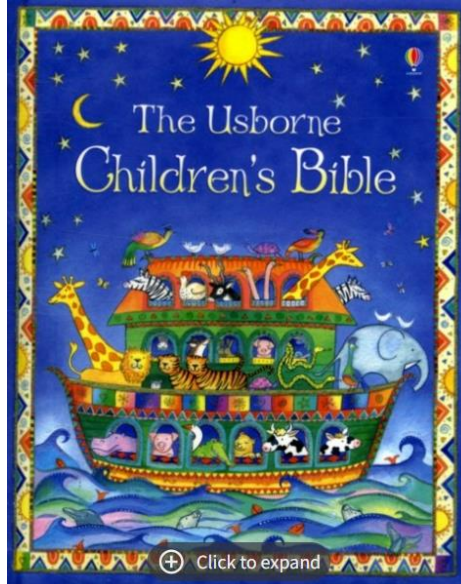
Christian	A person who believes in Jesus and follows his teaching.
