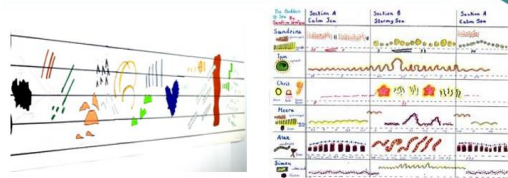
Forever Facts:

A nautilus is a type of underwater mollusc.

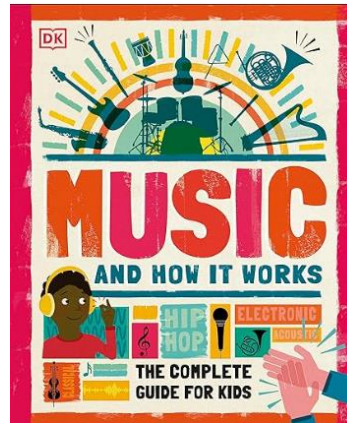
Nautilus blends acoustic and electronic sounds. It is scored for tuba, cello, electric guitar, drum kit, keyboard, and synthesised sounds.
