In French, I can say how I am feeling.

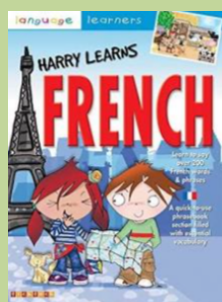
I can say goodbye in French in different ways.
