I am good at being a good friend, being healthy and painting.




I am good at racing, telling stories and cooking - yesterday I helped cook a fried egg.




I am good at tidying up, carrying big, heavy things and cooking.


Some people in families have a metal leg and some don't.

In my family one had big blonde hair but I have little blonde hair.




Houses and homes

We all live in different houses. I have two houses stuck together. My house is a big house on a farm. My house is medium and has one bedroom.




It's okay that we all have a different house.

- Pink with glitter + lots of family photos


Amy - Special because I have lots of teddies + like playing

- Help people.




If we see someone on their own, we can ask if they want to play with us.



The dog was lonely but he made friends with the dolphin in the end.


We can make friends by using our values - kindness and respect.



Standing up for yourself




If someone is mean to me I can say 'stop, I don't like that'.
