


I can discuss the statement: 'Genesis explores why the universe and life exists. Science explores how the universe works the way it does'

Knowledge within Christianity

Some Christians do believe that the text of the creation story is literally true — the earth is only a few thousand years old, God created it in six days of 24 hours

Some Christians see the creation story as communicating a message about the nature of God the Creator rather than the mechanism of creation.


