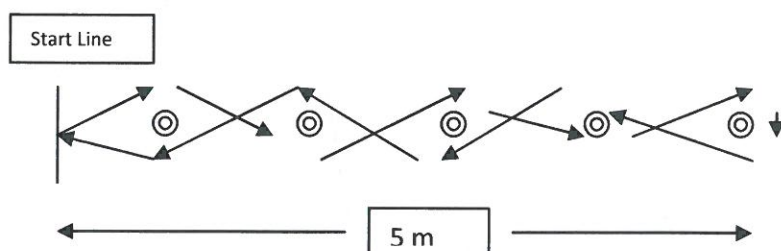
## APRIL 2016



**Basketball Dribble** Draw a start line using playground chalk. From the start line, put out 5 cones, 1m apart.
