### Information for Parents Regarding Lateral Flow Tests

On advice from Public Health England (PHE), pupils in primary schools and children in nursery settings are not included in the rapid asymptomatic testing programme. However, parents and support bubbles of school children can now get rapid Covid-19 tests twice a week - https://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-getting-tested

The DfE have asked us to share this message with parents:

- Test twice a week at home from now on (all who are able to).
- Report results online as positive, negative or void. This information is critical in helping to understand the prevalence of the virus across the country.
- Continue to test twice weekly over the Easter holidays.
- Test before the children return to school for the summer term, either the night before, or morning of, the first day back, to find and isolate any positive cases.
