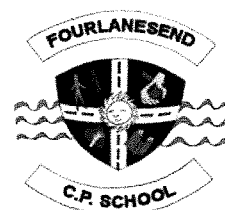

Whole School Attendance

This week, the whole school attendance is 93.8%. This is an improvement but below the national average of 95% and our school target of 96%.
