

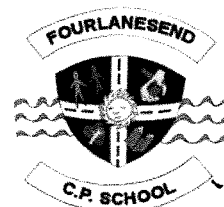

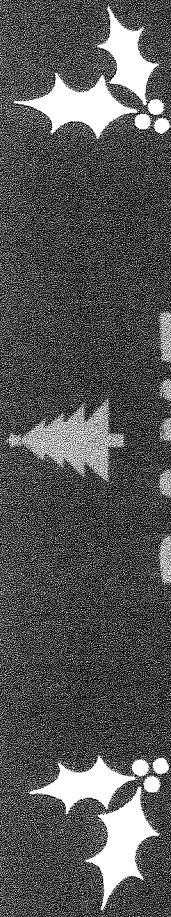
## Class News
