This analysis provides a comparison of attainment and progress in your school to other schools in Cornwall. All schools are ranked from highest to lowest for each measure and the outcomes are split into 5 (quintiles). Please see the table on page 2 to understand the variation in highest/lowest rankings and thresholds for each measure. Please note that where cohorts are small, the comparative performance may appear very high or low, however as the attainment data is calculated on percentages, it may not be statistically significant so please use caution when viewing this data. The rank/quintile takes into account the outcome value only, so it is important to also consider the "in gap" of any outcome as detailed in other analysis - for example a small school may have a high attainment percentage, however their "in gap" to national or LA averages may only equate to +1 child, but this school may be ranked higher than a larger schools with a lower attainment percentage, but an "in gap" of +6. This analysis does not take into account any cohort contextual factors which may have the potential to impact performance, including pupil mobility, FSM and SEN. Progress scores include the DfE progress cap. Attainment scores include the addition of 3 scaled score points for Special Consideration. School data is provisional. National and LA data is sourced from the provisional DfE SFR and includes state funded schools only.



The Key Stage 2 Comparisons analysis replaces the old comparison graphs, and is intended to show you how your pupils performed when compared to other schools in Cornwall. It includes the school and LA value, along with the rank and quintile for each attainment and progress measure. When working with other schools, this analysis may help you identify areas of comparative strengths and good practice, and support joined up working - for example within a MAT or trust.



The coloured box denotes the quintile and the value represents the rank against other schools in Cornwall. This is similar to the "old" graphs where the coloured line denoted the rank of the school. You can assess how close your school was to the next quartile using the tables below.



The tables below show the bottom threshold boundary for each quintile/measure. Quintiles are calculated to include 1/5th of schools each. This means the boundaries vary based on the distribution of scores. The "average" value may not always be in the middle quintile band. For example, the LA average for GPS Scaled Score is 105 - however schools with this value would be in quartile 4 (higher) rather than quartile 3 (middle). This is due to the distribution of scores. Each quintile will include around 45 schools, though this may be slightly lower or higher due to the distribution of outcomes.
