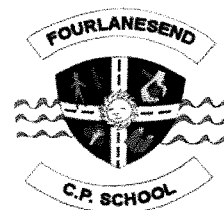

Covid Update

You are all probably aware that there is an increase in Covid cases in the area. This week we've had 11 children who are absent following a positive test result. 9 out of the 11 children already had a family member with Covid. At school we are continuing with all the effective measures we've had in place such as handwashing and ventilation. We've also made sure we use our outside spaces as much as possible. If your child is sat near someone who has had a positive result we will inform you as we are aware from experience now that this is the most common way of it spreading in school. We then ask you to test your child using a lateral flow. Please can I reiterate if anyone has ANY symptoms then you need to get a PCR test and if your child is unwell please don't send them to school - this was from Public Health England on Monday.
