Slap cheek

We have had a case of slap cheek in Year 1. Symptoms initially appear as:

- 'Flu like' illness and then the bright red 'slapped cheeks' rash appears followed by a reddish rash on the body. This rash may last for up to 3 weeks.
- A few children, but most adults, have mild joint pains.
- Headache, mild fever, sore throat.

It is usually a mild illness and some individuals have no symptoms at all. The incubation period is 6-11 days. Exclusion is not required as an individual is no longer infectious once the rash appears. We request that if your child does get diagnosed with this that you inform the school and also inform any one you know who is pregnant.
